

Implementing provisions for areas of support of the "Fund for World Church Tasks in the Archdiocese of Berlin

1. promotion of world church projects abroad

Dioceses, religious congregations, institutes and other church organisations with their own legal capacity are eligible to apply. The granting of funding requires a written application with the following contents:

- a. Name and address of the applicant and his position and task in the local church;
- b. Situation description for the respective project environment, i.e. parish, region, diocese, working area and social context;
- c. Project description with objectives and implementation plan of the project;
- d. Designation of the beneficiaries and groups of persons;
- e. Designation of the persons entrusted with the implementation;
- f. Recommendation of the local Bishop or the Provincial of the Order;
- g. Cost calculation and financing plan, from which the total costs and the participation of other cost bearers can be seen; an appropriate own contribution must be recognisable;
- h. Indication of the bank details for the transfer of funds.

Recipients of funding must confirm the receipt of grants and submit a report on the course of the project and the use of the funds.

When funding world church projects, for reasons of anchoring in the archdiocese, priority is generally to be given to those which have a relationship to parishes or groups of the local church in Berlin, or which are accompanied by the personnel deployment of missionary and development workers associated with the archdiocese.

In order to respect particularly important areas of use, the committee will draw up an allocation framework.

2. Christmas gift of the Archdiocese

The Archdiocesan Commissioner for World Church Tasks shall submit a list of those to be considered to the Committee by the end of October of the current year.

3. funds at the disposal of the Archbishop

For individual and direct requests, the Archbishop has 20% of the collection for world church tasks freely at his disposal. He may forward further requests to the Archbishop's Commissioner as project applications.

4. measures of world church education and public relations work

Measures by individuals, groups, associations, federations and initiatives that have a connection to the Archdiocese of Berlin are eligible for funding.

5. voluntary international services

Funding is available for women and men from the Archdiocese of Berlin.

6. international encounter measures

Measures by individuals, groups, associations, federations and initiatives from the Archdiocese of Berlin are eligible for funding.
